Minutes of the Tuesday, June 16, 2015 6:45 P.M. Business Meeting

The Montgomery Township Board of Education held a Business Meeting on Tuesday, June 16, 2015 at 6:45 p.m.

OPENING OF THE MEETING

- A. The Montgomery Township Board of Education held a business meeting on Tuesday, June 16, 2015 in the Upper Middle School Media Center.

- C. EXECUTIVE SESSION – A motion was made by Mr. Goldoni and seconded by Ms. Humza that the board adopt a resolution to go into executive session at 6:47 p.m.

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231 of the Laws of 1975 provides that a public body may exclude the public from that portion of a meeting of which the public body discusses certain matters for which confidentiality is required as permitted in Section 7B of the act.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Township of Montgomery in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

- D. RETURN FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION – The Board returned from Executive Session at 7:40 p.m.
- E. President Kirk-Csontos then read the following Statement of Open Meeting and Public Participation – In accordance with the State's Sunshine Law, adequate notice

of this meeting was provided by mailing notice of meeting on January 7, 2015 and June 11, 2015. Notice was provided to Board of Education Members, Montgomery Township Clerk, Rocky Hill Borough Clerk, Public Library, Township Posting, School Postings, PTSA Officers, Courier News, Princeton Packet, Trenton Times, and The Star Ledger.

- F. President Kirk-Csontos then led everyone in the Salute to the Flag.
- G. President Kirk-Csontos welcomed all to the business meeting.

NEW BUSINESS FROM BOARD/PUBLIC

Mr. Anthony Milano stated that he found out from his senior in high school that a board member is dating a student. He expressed his opinion that this was unprofessional.

Ms. Phyllis Bursh recommended a book on ideas for public service. Ms. Bursh requested a copy of the Superintendent's new contract. She stated that the Executive County Superintendent had already approved the contract and there was no reason to comment on the contract at the July 21st meeting. Ms. Bursh expressed her opinion that the board is rude and doesn't get along. She added that the public feels frustrated and angry with the board.

Mr. Charles Horn stated that he was at the last meeting and discussed concern with class rank being reported to colleges. He stated that he received correspondence from Ms. Gartenberg and asked if the board members had a say in the response to him. He requested a legal opinion from the board attorney and intervention from the board of education on his request to retract and rescind his son's class rank from documents sent to the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy.

Ms. Annie Michaelson apologized to the board and public for the poor report issued from NJSBA representative Ms. Gwen Thornton. She stated that all of the board members were to blame. Ms. Michaelson requested that Ms. Thornton's presentation from the board retreat be posted on the district website. Ms. Michaelson explained her reason for resigning from the board.

Mr. Alan Wirsul discussed statements made at the board retreat by Ms. Thornton regarding board members not having power outside of the board room and that this is a meeting in public not a meeting of the public. Mr. Wirsul stated that the board instituted triple tier busing because it was ordered by the county office. He stated that the public should know what's going on and newly-elected board members can give the budget vote back to the public.

Mr. Dan Csontos stated that Ms. Bursh does not represent the entire public. Mr. Csontos congratulated the board for instituting triple tier busing. He expressed appreciation for all of the work and dedication the board members provide to the district.

Ms. Kirk-Csontos responded to Mr. Milano that she was not comfortable discussing the personal life of a board member. She added that there is no current policy preventing a board member from dating a student. She asked the policy committee to review this.

Ms. Kirk-Csontos responded that there is a specific process which needs to be followed with the Superintendent's contract.

Mr. Vic LaPira, school counsel, stated that a copy of the superintendent's contract must be submitted to the executive county superintendent before the contract can be submitted to the board for approval. The contract will be voted on by the board at the July 21st meeting. The public is permitted to comment at that meeting.

Ms. Kirk-Csontos added that the board had to provide 30 days public notice prior to the vote on the superintendent's contract.

Mr. LaPira responded to Mr. Horn that a legal opinion was provided to the board through the superintendent. After reviewing the information, Mr. LaPira stated that the form sent to the guidance office asked for the student's class rank. The form was completed in line with board policy. He stated that it was not appropriate to retract or rescind the class rank. He added that the guidance office and superintendent acted appropriately in this matter.

Ms. Kirk-Csontos stated that she has reviewed all of the documents thoroughly and consulted with the attorney and Ms. Gartenberg. She supports Ms. Gartenberg in her decision. Mr. Hladick, Ms. Humza, Mr. Huff and Mr. Doshi also expressed support for Ms. Gartenberg's decision.

Mr. Venanzi stated that the presentation from the board retreat will be included in the minutes after board approval.

Conditional Guaranteed Return. Chartwells guarantees that the return to the LEA from the Food Service Program for the school year will be \$55,000. If the annual operating statement shows a return less than \$55,000, Chartwells will reduce its Management Fee by the difference between the actual and the guaranteed amount, but in no event shall the reimbursement obligation exceed the amount of Chartwells' Management Fee, as set forth

above. The Guaranteed Return is based on the following conditions and assumptions remaining in effect for the school year.

1) CONDITIONS

- a) Cash and/or reimbursement levels from State and Federal sponsors do not fall below the levels estimated in Chartwells' proposed budget.
- b) The value of USDA donated foods will not be less than the value of USDA donated foods estimated in the previous Agreement year.

- f) The level of wages, salaries and fringe benefits will not exceed those included in Chartwells' budget. In the event of an increase in wages or fringe benefits payable to employees as a result of unionization or changes in minimum wage rates or taxes, the guarantee shall from the date of increase in wages, minimum wage rates, taxes or fringe benefits be adjusted by such actual increase.
- g) The number of participating health insurance participants does not exceed the level of participants in the prior year.
- h) The selling prices of Menu Pattern Meals and a la carte selections will not be less than the prior year.
- i) Service will not be interrupted as a result of fire, work stoppage, strike or school closing.
- j) The LEA and its representatives including but not limited to, school principals, teachers and LEA employees shall fully cooperate with Chartwells in the implementation of the Food Service Program. The LEA shall fully cooperate with Chartwells to limit the expansion of competitive food sales in order to maximize the gross receipts and other non-cash sales of the Food Service Program.
- k) The LEA shall have timely submitted all documentation for reimbursement claims, except where such failure is due to an act or omission of Chartwells.
- l) Make-up days due to inclement weather shall have equal or greater sales revenue as a normal day of operation for the period in which the inclement weather cancellation

occurred.

- m) The number of students eligible for free and reduced price meals will be no less than that estimated in Chartwells' proposed budget.
- n) USDA donated foods received by the LEA are compatible with the menus outlined in writing by Chartwells.

In the event the foregoing conditions are not met during the school year, Chartwells' guarantee obligation shall be reduced by an amount equivalent to any increased cost or loss of revenue attributable to the changes in such conditions.

In consideration of membership in NJSIG, the Educational Institution agrees that for those types of coverage in which it participates, the Educational Institution shall jointly and severally assume and discharge the liability of each and every member of NJSIG all of whom, as a condition of membership in NJSIG, shall execute a verbatim counterpart to this Agreement. By execution hereof the full faith and credit of the Educational Institution is pledged to the punctual payment of any sums which shall become due to NJSIG in accordance with the bylaws thereof, this Agreement or any applicable statute or regulation.

If NJSIG, in the enforcement of any part of this Agreement, shall incur necessary expense or become obligated to pay attorney's fees and/or court costs, the Educational Institution agrees to reimburse NJSIG for all such reasonable expenses, fees and costs on demand.

The Educational Institution and NJSIG agree that NJSIG shall hold all monies paid by the Educational Institution to NJSIG as fiduciaries for the benefit of NJSIG claimants all in accordance with applicable statutes and/or regulations.
