It is recommended the Board of Education reject the bids received from the following vendors pursuant to 18A:18A-22e since the purposes or provisions or both of N.J.S.A.18A:18A-1 et seq. are being violated:

The low bid submitted by *Great Lakes Hotel Supply Co., Southfield, MI* is being rejected because the bidder is not registered with the New Jersey Department of Labor & Workforce Development as required by N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 also they are not classified by the New Jersey Department of Treasury, Division of Property Management and Construction as required by N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-26 and the bid documents. Also, the bidder did not include pricing for installation of the walk-in cooler/freezer box requested in the specifications.
