PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Ceramics II

Ceramics II will challenge students that want to progress in the ceramic arts. As a 3D class students will be expected to create sculptural forms, while being exposed to experimental techniques. Student will also have the opportunity to further their skill on the potter's wheel, develop their own artistic style, explore concepts and begin to develop their artist voice in clay. This is a semester course that further explores the four major areas of study in the fine arts: Themes and Forms; Core Concepts; Techniques and Tools; and Culture & History.

STATEMENT OF NEEDS:

There are currently 198 students enrolled in our introductory ceramics course. Ceramics has become more and more popular with the MHS students since its inception 3 years ago. At this point, we have students who wish to continue their studies of ceramics beyond the introductory level. As such, we would like to add a 2nd level where those students will be able to explore more advanced concepts.

Budget will not be impacted by this course in the 2014-2015 school year as the materials/supplies/equipment needed are the same as those we purchase for the ceramics course we already teach.
