





## MHS Class of 2019 Snapshot

The **SAT** tests reasoning and verbal abilities and is designed to assess students' academic readiness for college.



## Class of 2019 Mean SAT Scores








#### **Naviance**


Naviance is a web-based program where students can access many resources to find out how they learn best, what they are good at and what interests them, and how they can use that information to set goals and plan their future.

Utilized in grades 7-12














## **College Visits to MHS**


In 2018-19 school year 146 colleges visited MHS 1186 students registered for those visits






## **Counselor Visits to Colleges**

Counselors have also visited colleges with unique programs or offerings to better inform our families.


